
 Idaho is in top 10 states for highest mortality from AD






Scope: households in Idaho, selected places in Idaho, and entities that contain Idaho

Diagnostic Workup

Initial Care Planning

Transitions in Later
Stages



Optimal Multidisciplinary Workup



Medical

Initial cog screening

Detailed hx (acute or insidious onset?)

Labs for reversable causes

Baseline imaging (CTH at min.)

Pharmacy Consult Specialists, PRN



Caregiver

Understanding of the changes

Basic knowledge of the condition(s)

Personal psychiatric stability

Caregiver Burnout

Caregiver Distress



Context

Family history of supporting PLWD

Home safety

Social supports (e.g., friends, neighbors, faith community)

Community resources



Planning

Advanced Planning Directives (Living Will, DPOA, POST)

Guardianship / Conservatorship

Initial Care Planning



Addressing most distressing symptoms / behaviors



Building a Care Team



Helping PLWD and their caregivers cope with diagnosis



Clarifying goals of care and life planning




Navigating tensions between maximizing **Safety**, honoring **Autonomy**, maintaining **Dignity**.






Dream Team: Supporting PLWD and Caregivers

Planning for Transitions



- Common questions:
 - What can we do to keep my spouse at home with me?
 - How do I know it's no longer safe for Mom to stay at home?
 - When do we transition from Assisted Living to Skilled Nursing (or Memory Care)?
 - Is Palliative Care appropriate? If so, what do they do?
 - When is it time to go on Hospice?



Planning for Transitions

Medical

- Care needs
- Medical stability
- Functional status

Caregiver

- Personal health status
- Emotional resilience
- Caregiving values

Resources

- Available inhome supports
- Ability to bring in private care
